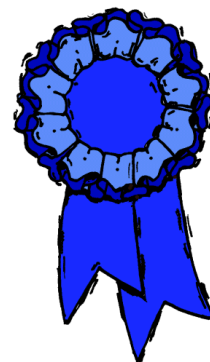

\*Entry fee per class - \$5 except class 28 & No Entry Fee for 32, 33 & 34- need to be entered w/4-H entries

\*One time office charge per back number - \$10

\*80% of entry fees jackpotted and paid out 1<sup>st</sup> -4<sup>th</sup> place. Ribbons 1st - 4<sup>th</sup> place Egg & Spoon pay top 4.

\*Working Ranch Horse – #30-34- \$15 cattle fee in addition to entry fee

\*Trail- in 2nd arena starting at morning break to run concurrent w/Performance classes for a limited time

\*Ribbons and money not picked up by office closing is forfeited.
